On Expression of interest for the construction, operation and ownership of the Power Plants listed in the list of potential sources of renewable energy in Georgia

Under the State Program “Renewable Energy 2008” - rule of approval of the construction of new renewable energy sources in Georgia, - approved by the resolution of the Government of Georgia #107 dated April 18, 2008 and on the bases of 4, Article 2 (o) of the Regulation of the Ministry of Energy of Georgia approved by the resolution #71 of the Government of Georgia dated April 1, 2006 the following shall be approved:

1. The “list of potential renewable energy sources” (enclosure 1) and be published on the official web-site of the Ministry (www.minenergy.gov.ge)
2. The expression of interest for the construction, operation and ownership of the power plants listed in the list of potential renewable energy sources shall be approved in accordance with the conditions set by the Resolution #107 of the Government of Georgia dated April 18, 2008 on the “State Program” Renewable Energy 2008” - rule of approval of the construction of new renewable energy sources in Georgia
3. The information about construction, operation and ownership of the power plants listed in the list of potential renewable energy sources (enclosure 2).
4. Interested parties should submit for the expression of interest for construction, operation and ownership of the power plants listed in the “list of potential renewable energy sources” in the form of application approved by the resolution #107 of the Government of Georgia dated April 18, 2008, to the Ministry of Energy of Georgia at the following address: 10 Lermontovi str. 5. Publication on the official web-site of the Ministry (www.minenergy.gov.ge) of draft of the Memorandum of Understanding to be signed between the Government of Georgia, Electricity System Commercial Operator (ESCO) and the interested party. The Memorandum of Understanding is mandatory for the applicants. The changes to the Memorandum of Understanding can be made with the consent of the Government.
6. The Administrative Department shall publish this Order and the information concerning the “list of potential renewable energy sources in Georgia” (enclosure 1) and about construction, operation and ownership of the power plants listed in the list of renewable energy potential sources (enclosure 2) in official periodicals distributed on the most parts of the territory of Georgia.
7. Department for International Relations and Investment Projects shall oversee the fulfillment of this Order and periodically publish an appropriate information on the web-site of the Ministry (www.minenergy.gov.ge).
